**FIRST YEAR 2018-2019**

	FALL	SPRING	NOTES:
1	Architectural History/Theory Course 1 (recommended: Design Futures: New York City)		Students typically begin the required design studio sequence in their sophomore year and may take one of five history/theory courses that count toward the major in their first year. The course, Design Futures: New York City is highly recommended for the fall semester of your first year.

1	Architectural Representation: Abstraction (offered fall and spring)	Architectural Representation: Perception (offered fall and spring)	Abstraction and Perception may be taken in any order but both are prerequisites for Design 1.
2	Architectural History/Theory Course 2 (pre-1750 elective)	Architectural History/Theory Course 3 (required: Modern Architecture in the World, offered spring only)

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**JUNIOR YEAR 2020-2021**

1	Architectural Design 1 (offered fall only)	Architectural Design 2 (offered spring only)	Design 1 is a pre-requisite for Design 2; Abstraction and Perception are both prerequisites for Design 1.
2	Architectural History/Theory Course 4 (post-1750 elective)	Architectural History/Theory Course 5 (elective)	
3	Cluster 1	Cluster 2	The Cluster is a group of 3 courses that relate to a single interest or theme that is relevant to architecture. These courses may be taken in any department and at any time. An example of a cluster theme is "New York City" (one course from Political Science; one from Sociology; and one from History). Students are required to consult with their adviser before they determine their Cluster theme and courses should be selected with your adviser's approval.

1	Senior Seminar (offered fall and spring)	Senior Course	Both the Senior Seminar and the Senior Course must be taken in your senior year.
