The courses listed below may fulfill a number of different distribution requirements for the majors and minor. Below are some notes on how different courses may be used:

- All non-studio (Architecture History/Theory) courses can be used as an Architectural Elective (ELEC)
- Senior Courses include the following courses taken during the senior year: 1) A second Senior Seminar in the department; 2) Advanced Architectural Research & Design; 3) A 4-pt Independent Study, with the approval of your adviser and the chair; 5) A 4000-level seminar offered by our department; or 4) A course offered by GSAPP or elsewhere on campus that is designated as a Senior Course by the Architecture Department.
- Only senior architecture majors graduating within two semesters are eligible for Senior Seminars.
