The courses listed below may fulfill a number of different distribution requirements. Below are some notes on how different courses may be used:

- All non-studio (Architecture History/Theory) courses can be used as an Architectural Elective (ELEC)
- Independent Study may be used as a Senior Course (not as a Senior Seminar) only with the approval of your major adviser and the chair. It must be a 4-credit project to count as a Senior Course.
- Other courses that may be used as a Senior Course include: Advanced Architectural Research & Design; a second Senior Seminar in the department; a 4000-level seminar offered by the Architecture department.
- Only Seniors or those graduating within two semesters are eligible for Senior Seminars

Other notations for distribution designations include:
